Day 1 Sunday, June 21, 2020 (D)

Arrive at Honolulu International Airport
Meet your Tour Manager, who will escort you through the duration of your activities
Transfer to your Waikiki hotel for check-in
Evening Welcome Pizza Party and overnight

Day 2 Monday, June 22, 2020

Breakfast at the hotel
Participate in a Musical Workshops at the University of Hawaii School of Music
Lunch, on own
Head back to the hotel for some time at leisure. You have the afternoon to enjoy a sailing adventure, surf lesson or to relax on the beach
Evening scavenger hunt through Waikiki that will provide knowledge of its history and culture. You'll be separated into teams with chaperones (who must participate), given a treasure map, a clue sheet, and a dinner allowance

Depart for Pearl Harbor and the USS Arizona Memorial. Today you will learn one of our country's most valuable history lessons - how men and women gave their lives on December 7, 1941 "The Day of Infamy"
Eat lunch under the shade of Monkey Pod Trees. During lunch, you will have an educational presentation by a WWII Historian
Performance at the Pacific Historic Parks Visitor Center as part of the National Festival of the States
After your performance, gather for an uplifting flag folding ceremony
Panoramic drive including The National Cemetery of the Pacific (Punchbowl), Washington Place which is the Governor's Mansion, the State Capitol Building, Iolani Palace and the King Kamehameha Statue
Performance at the Ala Moana Center Stage as part of the National Festival of the States
Evening Japanese style dinner. Watch as your Teppanyaki Chef prepares Japanese Steakhouse beef and chicken for you to enjoy
Return to the hotel for an evening on your own



Day 4 Wednesday, June 24, 2020

Breakfast at the hotel

Morning Eastern Shores Island Tour will start around Diamond Head and into the Beverly Hills of Hawaii, continuing to the Blowhole - where water can spout hundreds of feet in the air - and then to the Pali Lookout, where wind can blow so strong you can almost fly

Attend an Authentic Hawaiian Luau where you will be doing the hula, enjoying traditional Hawaiian foods, music, and entertainment

Evening Farewell Sunset Dinner Cruise on Honolulu Harbor. See the spectacular city lights of Honolulu and participate in Hawaiian line dancing
